Three children die every day as a result of drowning. For children ages 5-14, drowning is the second leading cause of death. At the YMCA, we believe that learning to be safe around water is not a luxury but a life saving necessity.

In our mission to serve all, the YMCA of the East Valley is committed to offering the Safety Around Water (SAW) program free of charge. Last year, 2nd graders from 28 elementary schools were bussed to the Y for our Safety Around Water program as part of their school day to ensure that no child slips through the cracks from receiving life-saving swim lessons." The most important part about this program is that the students are learning drowning prevention techniques...so they will be well prepared" says Cailey, a 2nd grade teacher whose students participate in SAW.

"The kids get really excited. It gives them an opportunity to practice swim lessons in a different kind of learning environment, giving them water safety tips to avoid drowning especially at this young age of 2nd grade," said Shelby, another 2nd grade teacher.


