I was born and raised in Iran, but due to safety concerns, I was forced to leave my country with my son, Kian. We lived as refugees in Turkey for eight difficult years, facing many challenges. Despite the hardships, I never gave up hope for a better future for my son. When we finally arrived in the U.S., I searched for a safe, welcoming place where Kian could grow, learn, and feel a sense of belonging.

A friend told me about the YMCA. It sounded like more than just a gym—it was a community. Since joining, Kian has participated in Kids Club, swimming lessons, SAW program, summer camp, and special events. His favorite activity is swimming. Even with limited English, the staff's kindness helped him feel included and confident. These programs have helped Kian build discipline, independence, and joy.

The Y has been a lifeline for us. Financial assistance made it possible to join, and the supportive environment gave us hope, connection, and purpose. It's been a bridge from the life we left behind to the new one we're building—with strength, gratitude, and faith.


