Since the day of Matthew's accident, I have stayed at my son's side. For the last 15 months, I've slept in my truck outside of the Totally Kids facility in San Bernardino (sub-acute facility), which Matthew is very fortunate to be in. I do not work, so my income is limited and uncertain. It was suggested to me that Matthew receive the benefits that can be gained through water exercise.

After speaking with the Y staff and learning about the financial assistance program, I was committed to starting our membership. Matthew and I enjoy the pools, which allow me to stretch Matthew's body without having to bear all the weight. I truly appreciate the YMCA and the exceptionally supportive staff that support us both.
